If the receptionist at the tourist information center is not available, please bring one "Kantakun Boarding Card" for the desired course set up in front of the sightseeing plan for each taxi and present it to the driver before boarding.

- 2 hours course ..... 1 unit 8,000 yen
- 2 hours 30 minutes course... 1 unit 10,000 yen
- 3 Hour Course ..... 1 unit 12,000 yen

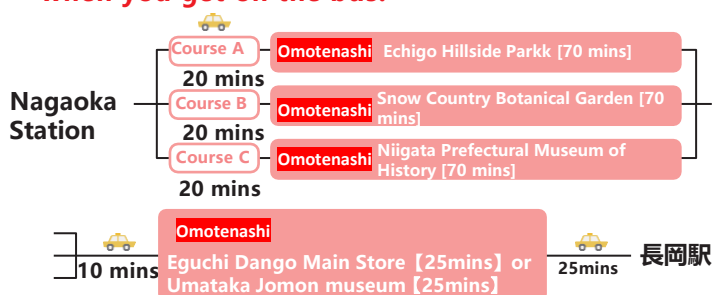

**Echigo Hillside Park**

You can enjoy a nature walk in the garden, where beautiful flowers such as snowflakes, tulips, roses, and cosmos bloom in all four seasons. For children, there are many fun playground equipment such as wooden playground equipment, water play area, and transforming rotation wheels.



**Niigata Prefectural Museum of History**

The life of the snow country in the Showa 30s and the life of the Jomon people in spring, summer, autumn, and winter are restored in a life-size diorama, and if you walk through the diorama exhibition, you can feel like you have traveled back in time.



**Snow Country Botanical Garden**

A botanical garden that makes use of the satoyama of a snowy country and carefully creates natural vegetation. You can admire spring snow camellias, snowcrackers, and other seasonal plants.



**Eguchi Dango Main Store**

A long-established dango shop in Nagaoka. Surrounded by Satoyama and a river, the store is a renovated old folk house, where you can enjoy sweets, the good old scenery, and a relaxing time.



**Umataka Jomon museum**

A museum where you can learn about fire-fired earthenware and the unevenness of Jomon. The original "fire-fired earthenware" and other rich archaeological materials are on display.

**Nagaoka Fireworks Museum**  
☎0258-86-7766  
It is a facility where you can enjoy Nagaoka fireworks all year round, and there are also plenty of restaurants and souvenir shops. The Dome Theater, where you can experience Nagaoka fireworks, shows four times a day. (11:00, 13:15, 14:45, 16:15) (about 35 minutes)



**Hotokusan Inari shrine**  
☎0258-92-3341  
A magnificent shrine with bright colors and a huge torii gate. Here, you can light five-colored candles, each with a meaning, and pray to the three deities that are enshrined here.



**Asahi syuzo, the village of sake**  
☎0258-92-6070  
A facility adjacent to the brewery "Asahi Shuzo" that manufactures Kubota. In addition to Japan sake, we have original products such as sake appetizers and sweets that can only be tasted here with the theme of "rice, sake, lees, and koji"



**Maple garden**

A villa and Japan garden built by the Takahashi family, who were large landowners of Kamiya, in the Meiji era. During the autumn foliage season, maples and maples are dyed in vivid colors.



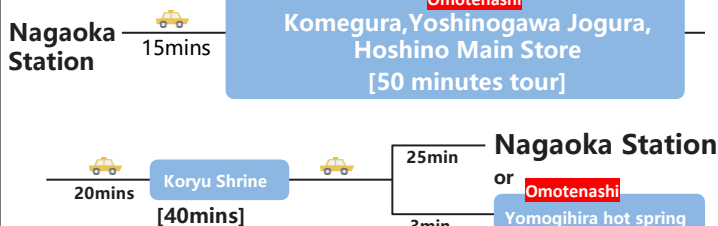
**Kokorate**  
☎0258-86-5208  
A tourist information center in the Koshiji area. There is a café, bakery, and Korean restaurant in the food court on the first floor, and you can buy souvenirs such as Iwatsuka Confectionery's rice crackers at the shop.

**Settaya Brewing Town**  
There are many breweries that brew sake, miso, soy sauce, etc., and the smell of koji wafts out of nowhere, and you can stroll around the historic townscape such as the old Mikuni Highway, which was called the Prince's Highway.



**Komegura**  
☎0258-86-8545  
The former Kina Saffron Sake Production Honpo is the mansion and brewery of Jintaro Yoshizawa, who made a fortune in "saffron sake" from the Meiji era to the Showa era. There is a café and a souvenir shop in the rice storehouse. The adjacent trowel storehouse is also a highlight.



**Yoshinogawa Jogura**  
☎0258-77-9910  
Located on the grounds of the Yoshinogawa brewery, there is a SAKÉ bar and shop where you can taste sake, as well as an exhibition space that introduces sake brewing and history using video and digital technology.



**Hoshino Main Store**  
☎0258-33-1530  
A miso and soy sauce brewery founded in 1846. We also sell our products in a renovated building built at the end of the Edo period. Freeze-dried miso soup is popular



**Koryu Shrine**  
☎0258-23-2020  
The shrine is said to be the god of business prosperity, and is visited by worshippers from all over the prefecture and all over the country. It is located in a beautiful area surrounded by mountains on three sides, and has a mystical atmosphere.

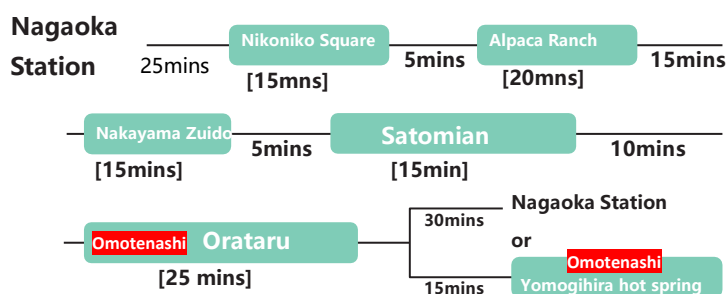

**Nikoniko Square**

In Yamakoshi, terraced rice paddies and tanaikes where Nishiki carp grow are scattered throughout the area, and the "Nikoniko Square" on the hill is a great spot to overlook the terraced rice fields and terraced ponds.



**Alpaca Ranch**

Cute alpacas with adorable big eyes and fluffy fur are very popular! You can feed them and touch them.



**Nakayama Zuido**

It is Japan's longest hand-dug tunnel, which took 16 years for local residents to dig with a pickaxe. It is a valuable civil engineering heritage that conveys the great energy and struggle of our ancestors, including the traces of pickaxes that still remain today.



**Satomian**

Photos and documents from the time of the Great Chuetsu Earthquake are on display, and you can freely tour them, and there is also a direct sales store selling local agricultural products.



**Orataru**

As a base for the revitalization of mountainous areas, we will pass on to future generations the experience of the Niigata Prefecture Chuetsu Great Earthquake disaster and the progress of reconstruction to the present. It is an exchange facility that disseminates the gratitude of "thank you" and the charm of the community to the whole country.

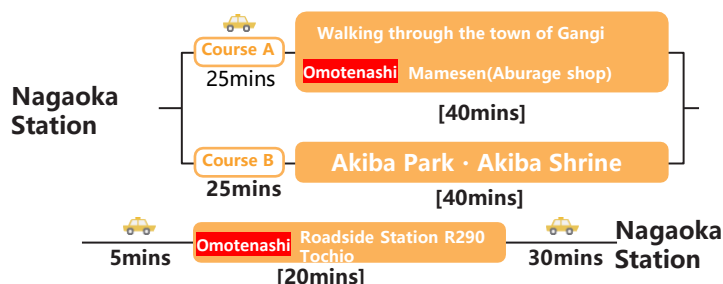

**Gangi**

Gangi is a winter road that is made by sticking out a long piece of hisashi from the eaves of the house to protect against snow. In Tochio, you can enjoy a nostalgic time by walking around the town of Gangi, which is unique to the snow country.



**Aburage**

The size is about 20 cm in length, 8 cm in width, and 3 cm in thickness, and at first glance it looks like thick fried, but it is a huge fried oil that is cooked all the way through. More than a dozen tofu shops compete for taste in the Tochio area.



**Akiba Shrine**

This shrine is located in Akiba Park, located on the opposite bank from the ruins of Tochio Castle, where Uesugi Kenshin was founded. Okunoin was carved in 1858 by Uncho Ishikawa and Gentaro Kobayashi over a period of eight years. There is a bronze statue of Kenshin in the park.



**Roadside Station R290 Tochio**

Roadside station where you can enjoy freshly fried aburage, a Tochio specialty. The product sales corner carries Tochio aburage, Tochio temari, Tochio local sake, and more.
